Woven baby and children's garments made of CO white & dyed fabric and PES white only. All with & without embroidery (normal & applique made of PES pile fabric and with sequins), with & without piece print with (water base pigment, plastisol (Both including fluorescent colours), puff (could be coloured with plastisol only) and glitter). With or without silicon heat transfer print. Include accessories (sewing threads, plastic buttons, metal accessories, plastic & metal zips (incl. recycle zips), elastic tape, white & coloured PES bands & cords, satin tape & Bows made of PES, padding & interline, ribbons, plastic squeaker, white woven tapes made of PES and PA, woven, printed labels, (incl. recycle label) and heat transfer labels) included in the trademark Püttmann Stummer"

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
